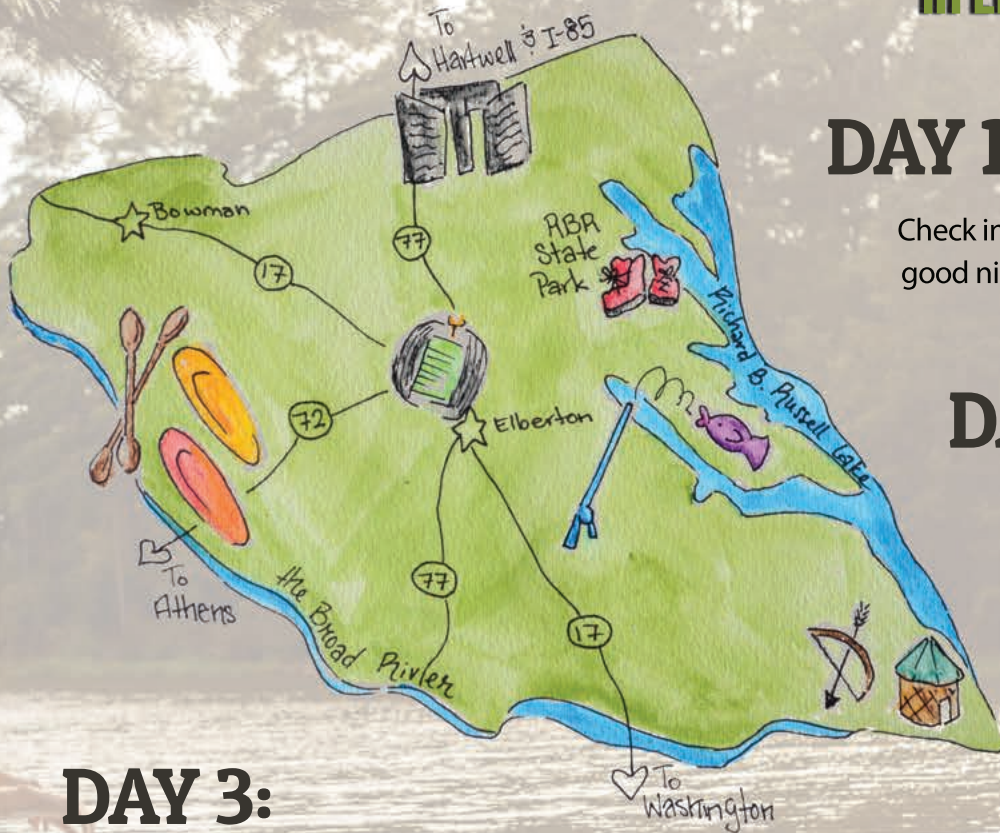


CARVE OUT 48 HOURS of outdoor adventures in Elbert County, Georgia



DAY 1:

Check into your **lakeside cabin** or **yurt** and get a good night's rest- you're going to have a fun day tomorrow!

DAY 2:

Get up early, because you don't want to miss a minute of lake day. Spend the morning fishing (or just cruising) all 26,000 acres of **pristine Lake Russell**. When you get back on land, enjoy a different view of the lake from one of the many **hiking trails** at Richard B. Russell State Park. After lunch, head to Bobby Brown Park to master the **3-D archery course**. Favor a rifle over a bow? Head to the **Elbert County Gun Club** and shoot clays over abandoned quarries.

DAY 3:

Rent **kayaks** and explore another water source in Elbert County: **The Broad River Water Trail**. This water trail extends the entire west side of the county and includes hidden ecological treasures like the rare Anthony Shoals water lillies. Once you've got your fill of water adventures, head inland to appreciate why Elberton is called "The Granite Capital of the World." Check out the 20,000 person **Granite Bowl football stadium** in quaint downtown Elberton. See another use of Elberton's famed granite on your way out of town at the **Georgia Guidestones**: a giant granite monolith perched at the highest point in the county.

Only 2 hours from Atlanta and 30 minutes to Athens, Elbert County is an easy escape from hectic life. Outdoor enthusiasts of all levels will love our adventure options!
